D.P.S. Road Test Instructions – ADULT COURSE

Please read the instructions carefully. Feel free to ask for any clarification you may need.

Call to request an appointment. Please arrive at least 10 minutes prior to your appointment time. 903-984-3843. Our physical address is 507 E. Kay Street, across from the Kilgore City Park.

A fee of \$50 will be charged to conduct the driving test. This allows you up to three chances to pass for no additional fee. Payment must be made upon arrival. Cash or debit/credit cards only accepted for payment. No checks. No refunds. (This fee is subject to change without notice.)

Bring **all** the correct documents exactly as listed. There are no exceptions:

- Current student driving permit issued by Texas DPS (**Cannot be expired**)
- "IMPACT" online video completion certificate (Cannot be expired)
 - Age 18-24- Impact Texas Young Drivers
 - Age 25 & up- Impact Texas Adult Drivers

Once the student passes the driving test, take the sealed test results and original or certified copy of birth certificate to any DPS office for processing (to schedule an appointment, visit www.dps.texas.gov). If the student doesn't pass the test, they must wait 24 hours before retesting.

Students must be able to successfully demonstrate the **correct ability** to parallel park. (We offer tutorials for an additional fee. This must be scheduled in advance.)

If you want to use our vehicle for the road test, there will be an additional fee of \$25 for this service. Please notify us in advance.

If you bring your own vehicle, it must meet these requirements:

- Must display a current proof of insurance for vehicle used for testing
- Vehicle must display a front and a rear license plate, properly attached to the vehicle
- All signals & lights, including the "high mount" brake light must work
- Horn must work, as well as windshield wipers (If weather requires)
- Inside door handles must work

If the original envelope we seal your completion documents in is opened, damaged, or lost, the test results and all forms will be void.
