

Applying For A Learner License In Texas for Adults

All documents must be original or certified copies. No photocopies are accepted.

- ☆ ADE-1317 Certificate- This is issued by the driving school once the student has successfully passed the permit written exam. (There is a \$5 fee for us to issue a duplicate if the original is lost or damaged.)
- ☆ Two documents that contain name and Texas residence dated within the last 30 days. (Texas Residency Affidavit form lists acceptable documents)
- ☆ One document verifying your citizenship. Most commonly this is an original or certified copy of the student's birth certificate.
- ☆ Student's social security card.
- ☆ Learner permit fee
- ☆ Impact Texas Drivers Video Certificate (<https://impacttexasdrivers.dps.texas.gov/>)

Contact the DPS office if you need a list of acceptable documents for proof of residence & citizenship.
